Please register at Camp Office when you arrive

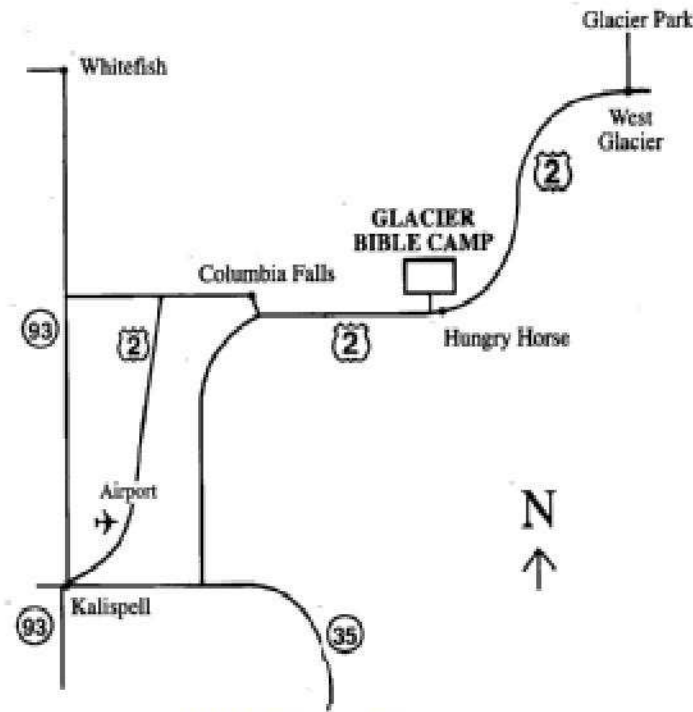
Registration is important in case of emergencies or messages.
