

## Dress Code Option for PK-6<sup>th</sup> Girls

The following uniform has been added to the dress code for HHCS preschool and elementary girls. In choosing this uniform our first step was to go to the Bible for guidance, keeping in mind that our goals are to:

1. Honor the Lord,
2. Encourage modest dress for our female students,
3. Encourage appropriate dress for our students,
4. Accomplish a more uniform look for the student body.

We realize there are many other kinds and styles of clothing that are acceptable and honoring to the Lord, but HHCS has chosen the following dress uniform to add to the established HHCS dress code for preschool and elementary students.

These items are **optional and voluntary and are in addition to the current dress code.**

Girls' pants (slacks), split skirts, and (preteen) skorts (a split skirt with a flat panel across the front) will be permitted in PK3 through grade 6 but must be purchased from the uniform company, [Schoolbelles](#), in the solid colors of **khaki, navy or black.**

Girls' pants (slacks), split skirts or skorts may be worn with the following shirts only:

1. Schoolbelles polo shirt with HHCS logo in solid colors of red, white, navy, or light blue,
2. Schoolbelles blouse with HHCS logo, available in  
2 styles: round collar or oxford,  
2 colors: white or light blue,  
2 sleeves: long- or short-sleeved,
3. Lands' End blue or red polo shirts with HHCS logo,
4. Patriot Sportswear red or blue polo shirts with HHCS logo.

Skorts and split skirts must be to the middle of the knee when standing or touch the floor when kneeling and must be in good condition (hemmed, not frayed). Shirts and blouses must have buttons buttoned to one button from the collar and must be tucked in and not "bloused out" below the waistband. Pants must have belts. Other clothing such as skirts, sweaters, socks, sweater vests and belts can be purchased from Schoolbelles. Permitted styles include crew neck, V-neck, or cardigan of standard waist length and may be worn over an acceptable dress code shirt or blouse.

All clothing should fit in a manner that is modest and neat in appearance. Clothing that is tight and form-fitting is considered unacceptable.
