KING JAMES BIBLE (Grades 1-12) All grades use the KJV for memorization and easy reference during class discussion. School store Bibles are required for Grade 1.

THREE-RING BINDERS. Grades PK3 and 3-12 need a 3-ring, loose-leaf binder. Spine widths are specified on the individual lists. Binders are NOT sold in the school store.

ART COVER-UP. Students in PK4 and students in grades 1-6 need a cover-up for art class. This can be an old shirt, apron, or any fabric (not plastic) cover-up that will protect their clothing.

BOOK BAG. (PK3-12)

SCHOOL BOX (PK3-6) Plastic box to keep supplies at desk, approximately 5x7 or 6x8 with a lid that closes securely.

TISSUES. (PK3-12) 2 boxes, 200 count per student

LYSOL© DISINFECTING WIPES. (PK3-6) one container per student

BOOK COVERS (Grades 2-12) We recommend durable, reusable fabric covers for hard cover textbooks and paper covers for soft cover textbooks. Both are sold in the bookstore. Please **no stick-on covers**.

GRADE 3 also needs

- >one 3-ring binder – 1 1/2” spine maximum
- >single hole punch

- 2 high liters
- >1 four-function calculator

GRADE 4 also needs

- markers
- 1 clear protractor
- >Elmers glue
- >one 3-ring binder – 1 1/2-2” spine
- >2 sets subject dividers for binder
- >1 three-ring **view binder** – 1” spine (2nd sem)
- >2 spiral-bound (one subject) notebooks (1 for each sem)

GRADE 5 also needs

- 3 folders with pockets only, no fasteners
- 3 pkg/100 **3x5 white, lined** index cards
- >one 3-ring binder – 1 1/2-2” spine
- >one 3-ring view binder – 1” spine (state report 2nd sem)
- >2 sets subject dividers

GRADE 6 also needs

- clear protractor
- metal** student compass (not plastic)
- 5 folders with pockets and fasteners
- 2 pkg/100 **4x6 lined** index cards
- 1 pkg/100 **3x5 lined** index cards
- >one 3-ring binder – 2” spine
- >2 sets subject dividers
