MISSION STATEMENT

Victor Valley Christian School, in partnership with home and church exists to equip students spiritually, academically, physically and socially in becoming exemplary Christians who impact the world for Jesus Christ.

PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION

Victor Valley Christian School's educational philosophy is based upon a God-centered view of truth as it is presented in the Bible. The Bible explains to us the true character of a fallen nature, and the need for regeneration through acceptance in heart and spirit of our Savior's redemptive act. The entire process of education is seen as a means used by the Holy Spirit to bring the student into fellowship with God and to develop a "Christ-Like" attitude toward all things. The student is taught to see all truth as God's truth, to integrate it with and interpret it by God's Word. Our purpose in life is shown to be God's purpose. Personal happiness/joy and vocational success is taught to come only when one develops their God-given skills and aptitudes in concert with God's glorious and eternal purpose for them. To achieve this, one must be "born again" and allow the fullness of the Holy Spirit to direct his/her spiritual, physical and mental being, upon Biblical principles.

Victor Valley Christian School's educational philosophy is complete in two senses. First, we direct our education to the entire man-body, soul and spirit. SERVICES

QUARTER MEETINGS

There will be a meeting each quarter for the purpose of accountability, encouragement, support, and prayer. At these meetings we will discuss parent and student progress, report on the preceding quarter, and provide helpful information and training. We believe these are important events, therefore if a family is not represented at one meeting, they will be charged a \$25 "reporting fee". This will cover the costs to communicate missed information. If a family is not represented at more than one meeting, they will be excused from the program. The dates for the meetings will be announced.

E-MAIL

Email is our primary method of communication. Emails will be sent to communicate upcoming events and meetings, give encouragement to our families, and inform families of legal decisions pertinent to home schooling. The Home School Director's e-mail address is dclarkson@vfassembly.org.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trips are great for educational resources, and for socializing with other families. While we are in different places academically, field trips can be a tremendous asset to your home school through preparation and follow-up. Field trip information will be made available at the quarter meetings and via e-mail, along with costs and deadlines. Transportation cannot be provided for home school field trips. If you desire to be involved in a particular field trip, simply clip and return the information sheets. Home schooled children must be accompanied by an adult on all fieldtrips. Adults must pay the general admission or other fees associated with the field trips.

STANDARDIZED TESTING

Each year in April a standardized test will be given to grades 2-11. This will enable the parents to see the strengths and weaknesses of the student and the academic program they have chosen to use for home school purposes. This test is mandatory for VCHS students and must be taken on the VVCS campus. The dates will be announced each year. Please do not schedule vacations during this week. You will be notified of the dates and times of the test as soon as they become available. The cost of this testing service is included in the registration fee.

VVCS LIBRARY

The VVCS Library is available for home school students and parents and is open at many different times during the week. The Library contains many books for adults and children. Parents are encouraged to use the Library with their children. Books can be checked out an individual basis. Please call the school office to schedule a time to visit the library. Damaged, lost, or stolen books and/or materials must be replaced or paid for. Students that do not turn in their books on time will not be permitted to check out additional books. Parents must supervise their children while they are in the Library. Respecting the classes and the rules that the Librarian has posted in the Library is necessary for the benefit of an educational library experience for all.

SCHOOL PICTURES

School pictures are taken each year a few weeks after the start of school on the VVCS campus. VCHS members may participate in school pictures by filling out one order form for each child and bringing the order form and money with the child on picture day. If the picture does not turn out well or the child is unable to be present at picture day, a retake day is available later in the school year. Please call the school office for dates and times.

COMPUTER USAGE

VCCHS students may use the Computer Lab at VVCS, with prior approval. The Library has computers and Internet access, as well.

HIGH SCHOOL GENERAL INFORMATION

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS AGES 16-18

According to the Education Code Section 48400, young people between their 16th and 18th birthdays, are required UNLESS EXEMPTED to be in school at least part-time until graduation. Enrollment in a private full time day school that has filed an affidavit can meet this requirement. The attendance supervisor of the local high school district may wish verification of enrollment. If you are enrolled with VCCHS and all requirements are current, the VCCHS Director will verify your student's enrollment.

Other exemptions include: graduation from a high school with a full 4-year course load; having received an equivalent amount of education in a private school; enrollment in a Regional Occupation Program Center; having passed the California State Proficiency Exam, or enrollment in adult education (if 18 years of age).

Students under the age of 18, who are interested in being employed, need a **Work Permit**. These are available at the VVCS office. The student's birth certificate and the application form with parent signature should be presented to the employer.

The requirements that all students must complete by the end of 12th grade in order to graduate are as follows:

Credits- A student must earn 280 credits (based on 7 classes per day, 35 credits per semester, 2 semesters per year) to graduate.

Social Studies-6 semesters as follows: 2 semesters of U.S. History, 2 semesters of World History, 1 semester of American Government, 1 semester of Economics

English-8 semesters

Bible-each semester that a student is enrolled at VVCS

Math-6 semesters

Science-4 semesters

Foreign Language-4 semesters

Visual or Performing Arts- 4 semesters

Electives-75 credits which can include the above subjects, or other electives

VICTOR VALLEY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL ACADEMIC ASSISTANCE

Some parents desire to have the assistance of Victor Valley Christian School in educating their children. High School and Junior High students (7th-11th grade) are permitted to take from 1-3 courses in the Victor Valley Christian Junior or Senior High School under the supervision of the teacher of that class. The following are some general guidelines:

If you desire to have your child enrolled in specific areas of study, fill out a Course Request Form from the VCHS Advisor.

If the course is open to new students the VCHS Advisor will notify you of the class schedules. A report card will be filed by the teacher. A copy of that report will be kept in the student's cumulative file and a copy will be sent to the parent.

Students taking classes at VVCS are expected to follow the dress and behavior codes that the full-time VVCS students are responsible to follow. If the VCHS student does not abide by the standards of the Victor Valley Christian School Handbook, he/she is subject to the discipline of the VVCS administration. It is highly recommended that the parents and junior and senior high school children that are planning to take classes at VVCS thoroughly read and understand the VVCS policies. VCHS students cannot "hang out" on campus, but must at all times be under the supervision of an adult or staff member.

VCHS DIPLOMA

Students working towards a Victor Christian Home School diploma with a college prep or standard option must meet the following requirements:

Course of study must follow minimum standards as set by VCHS.

- Student must complete and submit final grades for each academic course.
- Attendance Records must be kept by the parent and submitted at the Quarter Meetings.
- Report Card with letter grades must be submitted at the conclusion of each quarter.
- Students' work (called a portfolio) will be reviewed with the VVCS Principals at the conclusion of each quarter. This will take place in a private meeting in November, February, April and June.
- Portfolio items should include: writing samples, comprehension exercises, practice worksheets, quizzes and tests. Pictures of major projects are also advisable.
- Progress evaluations will be reviewed by the VVCS Principal.
- Transcript credit will be evaluated based on Victor Valley Christian School's credit system.
- Official transcript will be maintained by the VVCS office.
- Students who meet these requirements are eligible to participate in the graduating commencement exercises, as well as Baccalaureate.

VVCS DIPLOMA

A student may receive a Victor Valley Christian School diploma if he/she meets the following requirement:

- The child is a full-time student at VVCS for his/her junior and senior year and all of his/her credits transfer and meet the VVCS graduation requirements.

All VCHS students who wish to participate in VVCS athletics in grades 7-12 must be enrolled in at least one class on campus at VVCS throughout the entire school year for the purpose of developing camaraderie and a spirit of unity among team members and in compliance with CIF regulations. Practices will be held at the discretion of the coaches.

A fee per sport is assessed to help cover the cost of a uniform and the various expenses occurred in the program. It is due before the practices begin for the season. All athletes are also required to have a yearly sports physical before participating in a sport. One year of physical education credit is given to the student, on a one time basis, for participation in four sports at the in high school level. The season must be completed from start to finish in order to be considered "participation" in the sport.

For the privilege of participating in extracurricular activities, students must:

- Maintain a 2.0 GPA in all home courses and VVCS classes.
- Maintain individual class grades of no lower than a "D" in VVCS classes and home courses.
- Maintain good conduct (no "U" conduct grade).

SPIRITUAL EMPHASIS

Chapels are a time of fellowship and worship for the VVCS students and teachers. Chapel services for junior and senior high school are held on Wednesdays, and Chapel services for elementary are held on Thursday. Chapel times will be obtained from the school office. If a VCHS student is on campus during Chapel hours, they are expected to attend Chapel.

ADMISSIONS POLICY

The Administrator/Principal is given full authority and responsibility to administer the admission policies and standards of the school. Exceptions to admission policies or procedures will be made only in the case of strongly mitigating circumstances. Appeal may be made to the School Board. Their decision will be final.

All new admissions are for a thirty-day probation period. Violation of any of the established policies or standards will be grounds for termination of the student. Failure or refusal to fulfill financial responsibilities will be grounds for termination of the student.

Students will be accepted for admission to VCHS on a space available basis except in the following cases:

Academic Grounds for Refusing Admission - Students will not be accepted if:

1. They are two or more grade levels below the average for the grade in which they should enter.
2. They cannot earn enough credits for high school graduation by the time they are age 19.
3. They exhibit a record of absenteeism, failure to do school work, or a lack of cooperation with teachers or the school administration.

Spiritual Grounds for Refusing Admission - Students will not be accepted if:

1. They engage in or have in the recent past engaged in practices that conflict with Christian principles or morality of the law.
2. They or their families espouse beliefs, attitudes, or behavior that directly contradict the Christian beliefs expressed by V.V.C.S.

NOTE: It is not required that all students or their families claim Christ as their Savior; however, all parties involved in either VVCS or VCHS must be open to the message of salvation through Jesus Christ.

Social (Behavioral) Grounds for Refusing Admission - Students will not be accepted if:

1. They are presently or in the recent past have been disciplinary problems at their previous school.
2. They or their parents/guardians will not accept the dress code, rules of behavior, methods of discipline, or cooperate with the disciplinary actions of the school.

VCHS does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, athletic, and other school administered programs.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Be current members of the Home School Legal Defense Association or be in the process of seeking that membership.
2. Be in agreement with the Statement of Faith and educational and mission objectives of this school as outlined in the handbook.
3. Understand that VVCS is a tuition-based ministry and agree to satisfy tuition requirements.
4. Be committed to being accountable to the Home School Advisor and VVCS Administration with attendance records, academic records, and health records.
5. Both parents must be in agreement about home schooling their children.

ENROLLMENT

Parents will read the handbook and fill out the application packet. After the application packet is returned to VVCS with the application/testing fee, VVCS will contact prospective families for testing. This test does not qualify a student for enrollment, but rather determines at which grade level the student is functioning. Parents and prospective students will meet with the VVCS Principal. The purpose of this interview is to review the objectives and expectations, review the handbook and test results, and answer any questions related to the program. If you would like your junior high/high school student to take any classes at VVCS, a schedule will be set at this time.

ENTRANCE EXAM

The entrance exam test that VCHS administers is the WRAT Test. This one-hour test evaluates the student's grade level performance in three subject areas: Mathematics, Spelling, and Reading/Decoding. An additional Reading Comprehension section is included. The purpose of this test is to give parents/administration an evaluation of the level that your child is performing in the specific subject area.

REGISTRATION

There is an Application/Registration and Entrance Exam testing fee for new students (see fee page). This will cover the costs of the SAT tests as well. Upon submission of the registration fee, each family will schedule a test date with the Home School Advisor and VVCS Principal. He/she will answer any questions regarding the programs, review the results from admissions test, review the instructional goals for the children, and provide and explain the necessary forms for completing the school year.

RE-ENROLLMENT

If all of the requirements for the year have been met, a re-enrollment packet will be available on February 1st. If requirements have not been met, an interview must be scheduled by the member prior to July 1st in order to be assured of space in the program for the next school year (see fee page).

TUITION

Tuition arrangements must be made through our tuition management system, FACTS. Once your registration application is processed, you will receive an email message from FACTS asking you to create an account and secure tuition payment arrangements through their convenient online service.

The following are three payment options:

1. Pay all tuition before beginning classes, and receive a payment in full discount.
2. Pay tuition in two payments, the first half upon enrolling, the second half at the beginning of the second semester.
3. Pay tuition monthly. If this option is chosen, each family will pay the VVCS tuition once a month from August-June along with VCHS tuition.

REPORT CARDS

K-12 grade reporting will be due at the quarter group meeting. Parents are responsible for reporting for each student for each quarter (Use VCHS Report Card form). Families opting for a summer semester must make that clear to the school by June 1. A family that is extending the year through the summer will continue through the summer with the monthly tuition payments.

REPORTING

The following forms provided by VCHS are to be used for each student:

Daily Attendance

This should be kept accessible with the lesson plans or near the calendar. This will be turned in at the quarterly meeting to the Principal/Advisor at the end of each quarter.

Course of Study

This explains briefly what curriculum you plan to use and what grade level you plan to teach. This will be turned in the week before school begins each year.

Objectives

This is a more detailed plan of what concepts you will teach during each semester, and will be turned in before school starts. It is advised that parents use "teachers manual", which provide lesson objectives and other helpful information.

- Note: For those selecting the monthly payment plan, tuition payments are due on 1st day of each month. A late fee of \$45.00 will be assessed on an account when payment is received after the 15th of each month. There is also a \$25.00 fee for returned checks.

FAMILY PASSWORD

Victor Valley Christian School uses a "family password " in the interest of your child's safety and well-being. RenWeb (our school management system) issues every parent a password when your account is created. Your password is emailed to the email address you give to RenWeb, and your password will automatically be sent to us here in the school office as well.

When you call the school office to make changes to your emergency information, or request that someone other than those on your emergency list pick up your child, you will be asked to give your family password. If you cannot provide us with the correct password, we will not be able to make the changes or release your child. Please remember that your password should not be given to anyone but your emergency contacts.

2013/2014 Payment Information

This is to inform you of some changes in procedures at Victor Valley Christian School. Recent economical challenges which have impacted us all have made it necessary for the School Board to tighten our policies regarding tuition payment, delinquent tuition handling and tuition assistance procedures. Effective for the 2011/2012 school year, the following procedures will be in effect:

- Parents/guardians may choose from two monthly payment dates (5th or 20th of each month).
- Late fees will be automatically added to your account balance 15 days after your selected payment date.

Delinquent payments will result in the following penalties:

- 30 days overdue: All payment plan discounts, tuition assistance discounts and multiple child discounts will be forfeited for the delinquent month.
- 60 days overdue: Students will be unable to participate in sport programs.
- 90 days overdue: Students and parents will be notified in writing of possible student suspension if account is not current by the end of the month.
- Tuition assistance applications must be received in the school office prior to the start of the upcoming school year.

While the mission of Victor Valley Christian School remains unchanged, we must implement policies that will insure the continued viability of our school. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation as together we provide your children with a Christ-centered quality education.
